




### 12 Mile Hike along Hadrian's Wall

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#### **Meet our Occupational Therapy Team**

Caroline Clay is an experienced Occupational Therapist running sessions at the Heel and Toe Sensory Gym. Caroline is a trained Ayres Sensory Integration Practitioner and a trainer in Developmental Play.

Stephanie Snowball is an expert in dyspraxia and in movement coordination difficulties.

Both therapists are highly experienced and have a wealth of knowledge and expertise working with children. Occupational Therapy is a very popular therapy and has excellent feedback from the parents of the children who attend these sessions.



We do have capacity to take on new children and are currently taking referrals for the Autumn Term. Caroline and Stephanie will be happy to speak to parents about concerns or achieving new goals for their children.

#### What is Occupational Therapy?

Children's Occupational Therapy (OT) is all about improving function in children. OT covers a wide range of conditions and problems to promote function in relation to many activities children complete on a daily basis.

Some of the common conditions include: Autism, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Attachment disorders, Cerebral Palsy, Dyspraxia, Hemiplegia and Sensory Processing problems (SPD).

Some of the common problems we can help with include: delayed developmental milestones, sensory issues, poor handwriting, struggles to dress, undo buttons/zips, clumsiness, poor ball skills, difficulty balancing, poor hand eye co-ordination, poor fine motor skills, poor gross motor skills, low confidence and social and emotional difficulties.

Children learn through sensory experiences that include touch, movement, body awareness, sight, sound, smell, taste and the pull of gravity. The process of the brain organising and interpreting this information is called Sensory Integration. Sensory Integration (SI) provides a crucial foundation for later, more complex learning and behaviour. Some children learn differently and need more help to build foundational and functional skills.
